Romans 1:16 says that "The gospel of Christ...is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth." What does that power encompass? It includes the following:

- Deliverance from the curse of sin and eternal death [separation from God]
- Safety [Psalm 91:3-4] under his wings
- Preservation [1 Thess. 5:23] preserved blameless until Jesus comes back
- Healing [Isaiah 53:5] by his stripes we are healed
- Soundness Sound doctrine as an anchor for our faith on Jesus
