Psalm 57:7 says, "My heart is fixed, O God, my heart is fixed [steadfast]; I will sing and give praise."

Psalm 108:1 also says, "O God, my heart is fixed. I will sing and give praise..."

Fixed means to be prepared, set up, established and immoveable. Notice that the one whose heart [spirit] is set upon the Lord is the one who will sing His praise and give Him all the glory.

Psalm 112:7 furthermore says, "He shall not be afraid of evil tidings [news or situations] [because] his heart is fixed [steadfast], trusting in the LORD." As we fix our hearts, and trust upon the LORD, our praise to him destroys all that may come against us. As it is written in Psalm 149:6-9 which says, "Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two-edged sword in their hand to execute vengeance...and punishments...to bind kings [rulers]...to execute upon them the judgment written..."

Our praise destroys the yoke of the evil one. When our hearts are steadfastly fixed upon Jehovah, nothing shall in any wise bring us eternal harm. Our victory, safety, and security rest upon Jehovah [Father, Son, Holy Spirit] through our fixed spirit of faith; our fixed heart which does not waver or waffle.
