You will pay a maximum of \$35 for a 1-month supply of Part D select insulin drugs during the deductible, Initial Coverage and Coverage Gap or "Donut Hole" stages of your benefit. You will pay 5% of the cost of your insulin in the Catastrophic Coverage stage. This cost-sharing only applies to members who do not qualify for a program that helps pay for your drugs ("Extra Help"). Virtual visits may require video-enabled smartphone or other device. Not for use in emergencies. Benefits, features and/or devices vary by plan/area. Limitations and exclusions apply.
