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AARP MedicareRx Walgreens (Part D)

\$0 copay may be restricted to particular tiers, preferred medications, or home delivery prescriptions during the initial coverage phase and may not apply during the coverage gap or catastrophic stage. OptumRx is an affiliate of UnitedHealthcare Insurance Company. You are not required to use OptumRx home delivery for a 90-100 day supply of your maintenance medication. Other pharmacies are available in the network. Member may use any pharmacy in the network but may not receive preferred retail pharmacy pricing.
