## BABY BEACH RULES & REGULATIONS

The beach is restricted to members and limited guests. YOU SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK! There is no lifeguard on duty. Please be considerate and abide by the rules, so that our beach can be enjoyable and safe!

### Beach guests must follow current MA Covid Guidelines

**BEACH PASSES** Be sure to always carry and display your Beach Pass at the beach.

**HOURS** The beach is open from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Please do not swim alone or without another person who can swim.

**CHILDREN** Members are responsible for their children at the beach. No child, under the age of 12, is allowed at the beach without a designated adult member.

**GUESTS** Guests are welcome to use the beach when accompanied by a members. Only with the permission of the parent member, may a young member over the age of 12, invite a maximum of 2 guests. The parent, whether present or not, is responsible for the guests.

**SAFETY** Swimming is allowed only in the designated area. Please use your good judgement if markers are missing. There is no lifeguard on duty at Baby Beach.

**BOATS** The launching of any watercraft from baby beach is prohibited. Boats belonging to members may be tied up on the northerly (cove) side of the beach, while members are using the beach.

**NO ALCOHOL** Article XV of the Town of Groton bylaws strictly prohibits the consumption of alcoholic beverages on publicly used land.

**NO LITTERING** Please keep the area clean. Carry out what you carry in. No glass allowed.

**NO FISHING** No fishing is allowed on any part of Baby Beach. Fish hooks and lines are hazards.

**NO DOGS** No pets are allowed on the beach at any time, year round.

**NO PARKING** Baby Beach Road must always be clear for emergency vehicles and to respect the people who live there.

**ANY PERSON VIOLATING THESE RULES, ENDANGERING OTHERS, DESTROYING PROPERTY OR CREATING A NUISANCE, ON OR NEAR THE BEACH, WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM USING THE BEACH.**
