Best Practices:

- Give the flu vaccine to all members ages 6 months and older during flu season.
- Consider offering drop-in hours, after-hours, or weekend appointments for member convenience.
- Address vaccine hesitancy in parents by answering their questions with fact-based educational materials.

CPC Definition: Childhood Immunization Status - Combination 3

The percentage of children 2 years of age who had four diphtheria, tetanus and acellular pertussis (DTaP); three polio (IPV); one measles, mumps and rubella (MMR); three haemophilus influenza type B (HiB); three hepatitis B (HepB), one chicken pox (VZV); four pneumococcal conjugate (PCV) vaccines by their second birthday.
