



## Well Child Checks: 12-17 Years

## **Call to Action**



Sometimes a sick visit is the only time you see a patient, use these appointments as opportunities to complete a Well Child Check.

- What can you do today?
  Every day check your schedule for 1 sick visit to flip to a Well Child Check.
- How to prepare for next year?
  Since the patient is already in the office, this is a great opportunity to educate on the importance of well visits and schedule next year's well visit.

## Well Child Checks: 12-17 Years Definition

<u>Numerator:</u> Patients (Medicaid and Non-Medicaid) who are included in the denominator who were seen for a WCC at any UH RPCI practice during the measurement year.

<u>Denominator</u>: Patients (Medicaid and Non-Medicaid) seen at an office visit by an RPCI physician or advanced practice provider (APP) within the last 3 years who will be 12 to less than 18 years old at the end of the measurement year. Patients are attributed to the practice associated with their Epic-assigned PCP.
