

HCC Codes and Documentation - Extended

ADHD

F90.0-	Attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder, predominantly inattentive type
F90.1-	Attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder, predominately hyperactive type
F90.2-	Attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder, combined type
F90.8-	Attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder, other type
F90.9-	Attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder, unspecified type

Attempt for more specificity

Avoid broad terms and unspecified codes such as "ADHD", F90.9:

- Be meticulous in picking up the details in documentation
- It leads to precise coding and a better awareness about the disease and the population it affects

Use terms that specify

- Inattentive
- Hyperactive
- Combined

When coding and documenting, consider

- Codes within categories F90-F98 may be used regardless of the age of the patient
- These disorders generally have onset within the childhood or adolescent years, but may continue throughout life or not be diagnosed until adulthood.
- "Code also" notes within ICD-10-CM, function as alerts to highlight coding instructions within the text

Refilling medications

Don't forget to verify the condition and list the diagnosis in the Assessment & Plan including the status of the condition.
