

HPV-13 Vaccination

According to a 2022 CDC report approximately 37,000 people both females and males, are diagnosed with HPV-related cancers annually in the US. If you complete HPV vaccination before being exposed to the virus, it is over 90% effective in preventing genital warts, high-grade cervical lesions, and cervical cancer.

University Hospitals recommends starting the conversation about receiving the HPV vaccination early, at age 9, for both boys and girls.

The percentage of adolescents 13 years of age who have completed the human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine series by their 13th birthday.
