The Gators swept Air Force and Dayton on weekends, the latter with three run rule wins. They've gone on the road and beat Jacksonville and Stetson. The first home midweek saw the Gators top North Florida 7-6 for the first 2025 walk-off win.

The Gators followed up the walk-off by taking two of three (6-2, 6-3, 7-13) from the rival Miami Hurricanes, with over 23,000 fans in attendance over the weekend. Keeping Track - Gators in Professional Baseball

The Pete Alonso (2014-6) contract saga ended on February 5, as the first basemen resigned with the New York Mets for two years, with a player opt-out after the 2025 season.

In part due to a roster crunch in Detroit, pitcher Alex Faedo (2015-2017) was traded to the Tampa Bay Rays during the offseason. Despite fighting through some injuries in 2024, Faedo is reported to be healthy for the coming season and will compete for a spot in the Rays' bullpen.

Pitcher Michael Byrne (2016-2018) is still recovering from an injury in the 2024 season. Rather than sign with a pro team during rehab, Byrne has come back to Gainesville as the Student Assistant Coach.
