Christmas backpacks for Appalachia

It is Christmas in May! The Association has been busy getting ready for the mission effort to bring Christmas backpacks to children in need in Southwestern West Virginia and Southeastern Kentucky. The Lord has shown us abundant blessing in being able to develop relationships with schools and local churches in the area. Your support makes it possible to travel and meet with these folks.

We will begin collecting backpacks in August and ask that our churches bring the prepared backpacks to the Augusta Mission Center no later than October 31st. This year we will have opportunities for churches to be on mission in West Virginia November 30-December 3rd. We will need help getting the backpacks to the schools, sharing with the kids in the schools at fun fairs, while coming alongside our church partners in the area. We could use help with transporting the backpacks with trucks & trailers, or additional support to rent U-Hauls. We can also use help with supplies, hygiene products and new clothing for the schools.

Mission teams at the Mission Center

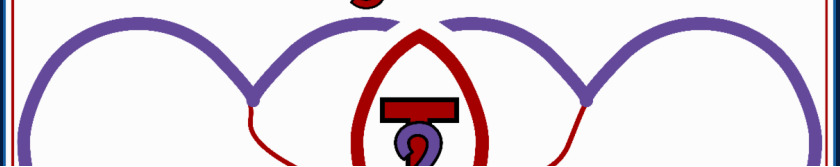

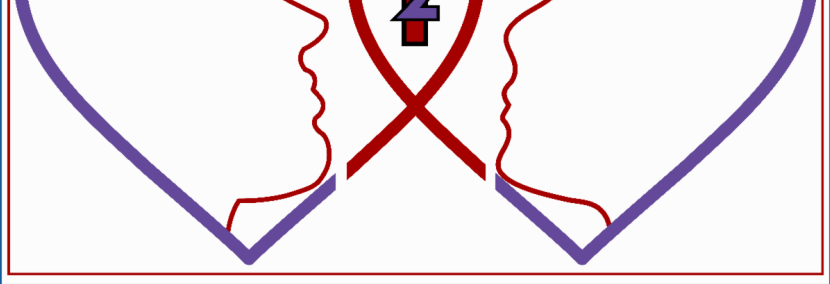
