## PARK OWNERS/OPERATORS

Compliance is your responsibility! Ultimately the buck stops here when it comes to insurance and legal claims, as well as regulatory compliance. How much do you know regarding ASTM F2970 and what your responsibilities are as a park owner/operator? Are you aware of your manufacturer's responsibilities? What you don't know could cost you tens of thousands of dollars and, more importantly, the safety of your jumpers.

## INSPECTORS

Are you familiar with the equipment you are inspecting in a trampoline or adventure park? Have you been properly trained on what to expect when looking at a trampoline court? Do you feel comfortable signing off on an annual or commissioning inspection? Are you properly certified in states requiring a TC Inspector Certification?

## MANUFACTURERS

It all starts with the manufacturers, but how many really understand their role as defined in ASTM F2970? A good portion of the standard applies to the responsibilities of the manufacturer. As more states regulate parks based on ASTM F2970, manufacturers will need to step up and make sure they are meeting their obligations to the park owners.

## PARK STAFF

Your park staff is the front line in your park. Are your court monitors trained to interact properly with your patrons? AAI's Court Monitor training is meant for new or existing employees and provides an understanding of the risks, roles, and responsibilities of their position.

# OUR PROGRAMS

... So Far

**What is AAI Certification?** A valuable reassurance to you and to the public that you demonstrated the application of knowledge and possess the eligibility requirements to provide varying levels of inspection and/or maintenance for Trampoline and Adventure Parks. As more states start to regulate trampoline courts, some are requiring parks be inspected by a Certified TC Inspector.

## Trampoline Court Industry Standards 101

This curriculum is based on ASTM F2970 and includes reviewing the sections and providing the attendee with the knowledge of how to navigate the standard and how to apply the standard to meet the requirements for inspections, patron education, manufacture design and modifications, owner/operator responsibilities, and more. This course will be offered online and at various industry events.

## Trampoline Court Inspector Level 3 Certification

Trampoline Court Inspector Level 3 can be achieved by attending our onsite (within a park) interactive training course. This course is a must for third-party inspectors, insurance inspectors, and state-regulated inspectors. In the future, IATP park members will be required to have their parks inspected by a TCI Level 3 certified inspector.

## Trampoline Court Inspector (TCI) Level 1 and 2 Certifications

For those who are handling the day-to-day and periodic inspections within your parks, if you have completed the TC Industry Standards 101 course and meet the requirements, you can apply to take the TCI Level 1 Examination and receive your TCI-1 Certification (upon passing). A TCI Level 2 Certification can be achieved by meeting additional requirements and passing an exam. These exams will be made available during various industry events throughout the year.

## Court Monitor Training

Our Court Monitor Training provides the student with an understanding of the risks, roles and responsibilities of their position. This course provides a baseline introduction to court monitoring and a greater understanding of how to engage the patrons and non-compliance incidents. This will be offered as an online course.
