NDOT SR 431-28 TAHOE PROJECT



Construction begins May 2022 for the SR 431-28

Tahoe Project! The Nevada Department of Transportation and Q&D Construction are working to revitalize and enhance the existing roadway and utility system, helping preserve pavement and protect Lake Tahoe.

The project includes repaving and some full reconstruction of SR-431 from the roundabout intersection with SR-28 to Mt. Rose Summit and along SR-28 from stateline at Crystal Bay to south of Sand Harbor State Park. The project also includes water quality restoration of the Marlette Creek drainage system.

Working hours: Sundays 8:00 p.m. — Fridays noon
Working hours include nighttime. All work is weather permitting and excludes major holidays.



Traffic Control

During the construction season and working hours:

- Traffic will be reduced to a single lane in work zones. Flaggers will control traffic flow in these areas. Drivers can expect multiple work zones and up to 30-minute delays.
- Commercial vehicles with air brakes are not permitted over Mt. Rose Summit from Mt. Rose Ski to Incline Village.
- Full road closures on side streets are possible. Access and detour routes will be provided in advance.

Below is a preliminary schedule for Season 2 work (May - October 2022):

The schedule is subject to change. Adjacent businesses and residents will be notified in more detail 7 days prior to when work will be conducted nearby.

| JULY | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reconstruct select roadway shoulders and cross slopes on SR-431• Soil nailing along the aging timber wall along SR-28 north of Memorial Point lookout begins• Begin milling and repaving 3-4 inches of asphalt on SR-431 |
| AUG | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Soil nailing along the aging timber wall along SR-28 north of Memorial Point lookout• Milling and repaving 3-4 inches of asphalt on SR-431 |
| SEP | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Milling and repaving 3-4 inches of asphalt on SR-431• Installing new curb and gutter on SR-28 to help preserve the roadway |
| OCT | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Milling and repaving 3-4 inches of asphalt on SR-431• Installing new curb and gutter on SR-28 to help preserve the roadway• Demobilize equipment and winterize project |
