The East Bay Independent Insurance Agents Association was originally under the Independent Insurance Agents Association of Contra Costa County and was founded in 1921 and incorporated on May 17, 1978. EBIIAA/IIAACC is a long-time respected organization that serves the interest of local Independent Agents. The EBIIAA dba name was added in 2011 after the Oakland, Southern Alameda Associations dissolved to be more inclusive and encourage those members to be a part of EBIIAA.

EBIIAA dues are billed annually. The annual dues are \$225. The EBIIAA fiscal year is 10-1 to 9-30 and the dues are billed on a calendar year 1-1 to 12-31 each year.

EBIIAA does not require members to also be a member of IIABCal. IIABCal, the state association and EBIIAA are supportive of each other in their efforts to enhance and promote the Independent Agent/Broker, Companies and Affiliates experience.
