Happy New Year, Independence! From all of us on the Board, we are excited to welcome a new season of growth and excitement to our community, and we hope that you and your families have so far enjoyed a happy and healthy January.

As we look to the year ahead, there are a few key milestones that I want to ensure you have front-of-mind as a homeowner and Member of this dynamic Association so that you can stay involved and informed:

- ☑ **Landscape Maintenance Contract:** The Board will be reviewing proposals, with the assistance of the Beautification & Maintenance Committee, from companies interested in bidding their services for our common area landscaping & irrigation maintenance. Our current contract with Down to Earth expires in February, so we will spend a lot of time this month and next ensuring that we set ourselves up for success by either renewing a new contract with DTE or welcoming a new partner to the community.
- Community Upkeep Projects: Late last year, the Board approved three major projects to help preserve and grow the value of our assets: 1) the construction of a retaining wall on Association property at Broomshedge Trail; 2) the full exterior repainting of Lake Trail Residents Club with an all-new color scheme; 3) the replacement of the original wooden pergolas at the Town Square Residents Club pool deck with new aluminum pergolas that will last significantly longer with less maintenance.

Three of our seats are one-year terms, so keep an eye out in the weeks ahead for more details about the 2022 election and how to participate.






