

A Message from the Assistant Community Manager

Happy August, Independence! As we wrap up the summer season together, it's a great time to start thinking about those fall leaves... the ones we don't have to rake in tropical Florida! While the leaves may not drop like they do in other areas, the trees themselves do need your attention.

Living in Orange County, all homeowners in the community are required to maintain the trees on the easement (the space between the sidewalk and the curb) to a **minimum height of 14 feet over the roadway and 10 feet over the sidewalk** by trimming away the low canopy branches closest to the ground.

If you're a long-time resident of Independence, you might be thinking, "hmm... I don't remember doing this before. In fact, I remember Orange County doing it for me." And your memory would be correct: up until recently, the County did provide this service. However, while the ordinance hasn't changed, the County no longer offers this complimentary trimming, which puts the onus back on homeowners to do the necessary maintenance (and on the Association as well—we also began trimming our own easement trees after the County stopped).

With our kids headed back to school, more vehicles and pedestrians are out on the roads and sidewalks, and that makes this responsibility even greater. If you happen to receive a covenant enforcement notice from our office, don't panic: we're reminding everyone of the need to keep trees trimmed even as we work through all the common areas doing the same thing. Just give us a call or send an email if you need more time to do this maintenance safely, and we're always happy to work with you to help maximize the value of your home and our neighborhoods.



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
