Lawsonia Links Course, reminiscent of the Yale's MacDonald Raynor monumental woodland course with cavernous bunkers has sought golfers willing to venture off-the-beaten path for an extra special golf experience. This classic William Langford and Theodore J. Moreau design, which dates to 1930, is ranked on the top 100 list of every major golf magazine. Few public courses in the country. Lawsonia's random berms and dramatic greenside walls is early classical architecture at its best and is kept in pristine shape equal to the best private clubs today. Here, the magic moment comes at the 161-yard seventh hole, the par-3 known as the "Box Car Hole". Legend has it that a railroad car was buried under the green to create such an extreme 20-foot drop-off on the right. Missing at the bottom is worse than being buried in a pot bunker



Sentry World is Wisconsin's premier parkland golf course. An iconic Robert Trent Jones Jr. designed course with a rich history, Sentry-World blazed the trail as Wisconsin's first destination golf course. The inaugural round was played on June 13, 1982 and the course quickly became famous for its world class caliber and stunning signature "Flower Hole." In 2013, Robert Trent Jones Jr. returned to Sentry-World, and in collaboration with course architects Bruce Charlton and Jay Blasi, oversaw a major renovation to the 200-acre course. Boasting upgrades, improvements and changes to everything from its layout, greens, grasses and bunkers to its irrigation system, water features and even the onsite sports complex, the reimagined SentryWorld has reclaimed its place as Wisconsin's premier parkland golf course and is a must-play destination for golfers of all skill levels.



Whistling Straights Is open, rugged and windswept terrain defines the walking-only, links-style Straits Course sculpted along two miles of Lake Michigan shoreline. Whistling Straights offers two courses which have hosted the PGA Championship, U.S. Senior Open and the Palmer Cup. Plumbing magnate Herb Kohler wanted to expand the already-brisk golf business at his popular resort, Destination Kohler, near Sheboygan, about an hour-and-change from Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He had 36 holes on the resort proper, but found 560 lakeside acres about ten miles northeast of the resort itself. The property was an ecological ruin filled with asbestos, toxic waste, concrete bunkers and fuel storage tanks, but it also featured 70-foot bluffs rising above the waters of Lake Michigan. "I want this course to look like it's in Ireland," was the directive handed down by Herb Kohler.



Sand Valley, aptly named the Bandon Dunes of the Midwest also not surprising since it's another of Mike Kaiser's great creations. Now with three exceptional sand-based creations, the original Sand Valley by Coore-Crenshaw course opened in 2017 shows their usual routing and strategic brilliance with many memorable shot making options and challenging vistas. Followed last year by David Kidd's Mammoth Dunes built on a much larger scale that some say, following the designer's reputation for erratic and dynamic layouts, dwarfs the original Coore-Crenshaw design. Mammoth's many more memorable holes requires greater shot-making and focus which leaves the golfer more fatigued by the extra effort yet buoyed by the challenge. The Coore-Crenshaw Sandbox par-three adds a unique but true golf dunes challenge and excitement to this trilogy of the grand Wisconsin landscape.
