**Forte Hotel Amigo**, located in Brussels's Lower Town neighborhood, **Rocco** is in the city center an near notable landmarks La Grand Place and Royal Palace of Brussels. **Royal Waterloo Golf Club** was funded in 1923 when golf was played at Rhode-Saint-Genese. In 1960, the club moved to Lasne, its present location at the center of the historic Waterloo Battlefields. Of the 54 four holes at Waterloo La Marache is the premier course, originally designed by Fred Hawtree in 1960. He also designed Royal Waterloos three other challenging nine-hole layouts. La Marache's greens were redesigned in 2007 by Hawtree. The course set in a delightfully undulating woodland location is often underrated, nevertheless Royal Waterloo Golf Club has hosted prestigious international professional and amateur tournaments since its inception: the Open de Belgique on several occasions, the Challenge Donald Swaelens and the International Ladies Open



**The Royal Golf Club of Belgium** - "Royal" since its foundation in 1906 by King Leopold II - is laid on the Ravenstein Farm-land and the Ravenstein Manor has become the Club House. After several changes of ownership, the property was bought from the Belgian State in 1880 by King Leopold II in 1903 to become the Club property. It's uncertain of who designed the course at Ravenstein, but it was at least inspired by Seymour Dunn, "the architect of the Kings". In 1951 P. Mackenzie Ross designed the new course to a length of 3819 meters. In 1990 the course underwent a 10 year modernizing program by architect, Martin Hawtree, to make it a more challenging test. In 1996 King Albert II accepted the title of President of Honor of the Royal Golf Club of Belgium.



**Royal Golf Club ,Oostend.** At the end of the nineteenth century, King Leopold II decided to make Ostend more attractive for British tourists by establishing a golf course, designed by Seymour Dunn and inaugurated on July 1903. After the First World War, the course and the clubhouse were completely destroyed and had to be rebuilt. The same happened during the Second World War and it was restored in 1948. From 1950, the Belgian Royal family, especially King Leopold III often played the course. During the nineties, the course underwent a renovation by the architect Martin Hawtree. The Royal Oostend Golf Club after 100 years of existence, will be the first golf club in Belgium to maintain for its members its original, typical 'links' character.



**Royal Zoute Golf** was first played at Knocke-sur Mer at the turn of the century in 1899. Originally an off-shoot of the Bruges Golf and Sports club, it continued under the management of Bruges until 1909, when the two clubs agreed to separate and it became the 'Knocke Golf Club an 18 hole links course. In 1909, the Clubhouse was built on the Binnenhof, the highest dune with sea views and was nicknamed the villa 'monkey house' because of the climb to reach it. The villa remains close to the back tee of the 15th Play was suspended during the first World War, as the Germans used the course as a military field. After the war a new course was built on land belonging to the Compagnie du Zoute, and the club was renamed Zoute Golf Club, designed by Harry Colt in 1907. Royal Zoute hosted five European Tour Belgium Championships.
