ANCHORAGE, AK – Four outstanding Alaska business leaders will join the Alaska Business Hall of Fame at the annual Junior Achievement recognition event in January. Business peers recently selected Linda Leary, Founder of Fishe, Joe Schierhorn, Chairman of Northrim Bank, Ralph Seekins, President – Seekins Ford-Lincoln, Inc. and a posthumous recognition for US Congressman Don Young, longest serving Republican in US Congressional History. These business leaders are honored for their direct impact toward furthering the success of Alaska business, demonstrated support and commitment to Junior Achievement’s programs, and demonstrated commitment to Alaska business.
