I've been sick, really sick, twice in the past. This second time changed me. It changed me in large part due to the beauty and kindness and courage of the people with whom I find myself inpatient.

Well, I guess I should say this first. I participated in Homeless Persons' Memorial Day when I lived in Baltimore. I currently help to organize the Greater Winston-Salem Homeless Persons' Memorial Day. Homelessness matters to me a great deal.

Some of my people with whom I was inpatient did not live anywhere close to the place in which their crisis had taken them. They did not have rides to get where they needed to be. There wasn't money for a plane ticket or even a bus ticket.

Twice a year Our Brother Legion takes up a special offering which will go to the benevolent funds of an inpatient place to help with the basic needs that folks might find themselves without.

These offerings will take place in May (Mental Health Month) and September (Suicide Prevention Month).
