

BYLAW #2023-02

PELICAN LANDING WASTE & RECYCLING SPECIAL SERVICES BYLAW SPECIAL TAX LEVY ATTATCHED "EXHIBIT A & B" SERVICE TO RATPAYERS ON LISTING

THE COUNCIL of the Rural Municipality of Calder No. 241, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

PURPOSE:

- 1. This Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Calder No. 241 in the Province of Saskatchewan is for the purpose of:
 - a. Entering into an agreement with Ottenbreit Sanitation Services (2002) Ltd. for the collection, removal and disposal of household waste and recycling services for Pelican Landing Resort premises; and
 - b. Fixing rates to be charged for the collection, removal and disposal of household waste and recycling services for Pelican Landing Resort; As LISTED ON "Exhibit B" and will be added to each TAX CARD AS A SPECIAL LEVY.

AUTHORITY:

2. IN ACCORDANCE to Section 8(1)(i) & (j) of The Municipalities Act; NOW AND THEREFORE,

HOUSEHOLD WASTE & RECYCLING SERVICES RATES:

3. Any person who occupies or owns an residential premise or Lot within Pelican Landing Resort as identified in Exhibit "A" shall have a special levy place on the tax notice on a yearly basis for waste & recycling collection, removal and disposal services at the following rate:

HOUSEHOLD WASTE & RECYCLING SERVICES:

4. The Rural Municipality of Calder No. 241 is hereby authorized to sign and execute an agreement, identified as "Exhibit B" attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw, with Ottenbreit Sanitation Services (2002) Ltd. for the purposes of providing household waste and recycling collection, removal and disposal services for all of Pelican Landing Resort premises within the in accordance to the General Guidelines as identified in "Exhibit B" attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.
