BYLAW #2017-11

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR THE CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

THE COUNCIL of the Rural Municipality of Calder No. 241, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as "General Penalty Bylaw"

AUTHORITY:

2. This bylaw is made IN ACCORDANCE to Section 381 of *The Municipalities Act*.

DEFINITIONS:

3. In this Bylaw:
 - a) "**Municipality**" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Calder No. 241;
 - b) "**Designated Officer**" shall mean the Administrator or other person designated by resolution of Council.
 - c) "**Council**" shall mean the Council of the Rural Municipality of Calder No. 241.

SCOPE OF BYLAW:

4. This bylaw shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.

GENERAL PENALTIES:

5. Every person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:
 - a) in the case of an individual:
 - i. to a fine not exceeding TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000) and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,500) for each day during which the offence continues;
 - ii. and/or to imprisonment for not more than one year;
 - b) in the case of a corporation:
 - i. to a fine not exceeding TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000) and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,500) for each day during which the offence continues.

Should you fail to attend the Regular Meeting of Council to which you were registered to be a delegation or should this notice not be disputed within the 14 days and payment is not received within 20 days, a summons requiring your appearance in provincial court will be issued.

PENALTY

IF PAYMENT RECEIVED WITHIN 20 DAYS

VOLUNTARY PAYMENT OPTION: Should the Municipality receive payment of the above amount within the time provided, the person receiving the Bylaw Violation Notice shall not be liable to prosecution for the alleged contravention but shall not exempt the person from enforcement of this order.
