Grab Bag Sale, Dec 12

Friends will not be holding its traditional four-day December book sale in 2020. Instead we will hold a grab bag sale on Saturday, December 12. We will have bags of children's books at various reading levels as well as bags of adult paperbacks ready for pickup from 10:00 to 2:00. All grab bags will cost \$5, and there is no limit to the number of bags one may purchase.


Children's book categories include:

- Easy (infants to 5 years old) 10 picture read-a-louds and either 5 board books or 5 story books
- **Junior Early Readers** (children 5 to 8 years old) 10 picture read-a-louds and either 5 chapter books or 5 story books
- Middle (children 8/9 to 12 years old) 15 chapter books or a mix of fiction, nonfiction and chapter books (15 total)
- Young Adult (teenagers) a mix of 10 hard and softcover novels

Adult paperback categories include Romance, Mystery/Thriller or General Fiction, and there will be 15 paperback books in each bag.

The sale will take place at the west end, loading dock, of the downtown branch. Customers will be required to stay in their cars. Bags of books will be placed into trunks or through the back-seat window by Friends' volunteers. We ask those making purchases to enter the library parking lot via Alabama or 7th Streets, and everyone will exit on to South Street. All Friends' volunteers will be wearing masks during this event, and we ask that buyers wear masks as well.


