# **Book Sale Update**

Our next book sale is scheduled for December 10 to 13. Friday night is open to Friends only from 7:30 to 9:30 P.M., and memberships may be purchased at the door. So far, we have 15 boxes of Christmas and Gift Quality Adult books and 20 boxes of Christmas, Channukah and Gift Quality Children's books packed for this sale. Our media collection includes holiday music as well. Do not forget many of our Puzzles are of great quality (some have never been opened) and make fine gifts, too.

As in the past you will find Adult Fiction categories and Children's books in the main and north lobbies. The Christmas and Gift Books will also be found in the lobbies. Our Nonfiction categories and Media will be in found in the McAllister Room. Just to let everyone know in advance, the media will be spread out around the McAllister Room for this book sale. All sections will be labeled; you will just have to wander a bit to view all selections. Teachers will be able to apply a 10% discount to their Friday and Saturday purchases.

For our December 2021 book sale, the Sunday times will be from 1:00 to 5:00. It will still be a  $\frac{1}{2}$  price event, and we have added that patrons may purchase a bag of books for \$8. There will be no limit to the bags purchased. We realize that  $\frac{1}{2}$  price children's picture books at  $25\phi$  each might be a better deal, but this would only be so for the larger over-sized books. This December we will be keeping track of the numbers of Sunday visitors and whether they choose  $\frac{1}{2}$  price purchases or \$8 bags.


#### 2022 Book Sale Dates
