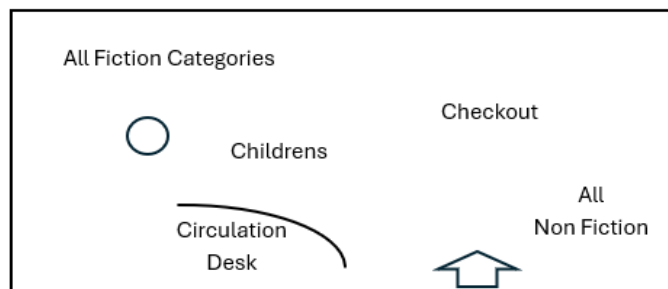

Instead, as you pass the greeting desk and walk towards Circulation, you will find our various Children's books categories extending west. We have a wonderful selection of Practically Perfect picture books and novels to start. Next will come EASY board, picture, and simple readers, then JER picture books and short novels. We have a full selection of Middle fiction and nonfiction picture books and novels for children to enjoy too.

When first entering the library, via the south entrance from the parking lot, you can wander through the more than 40 tables of nonfiction categories in the McAllister Room. Indiana, Classics, and Art will be well represented on the north side. We have ten boxes of House and Gardening books (name the plant or the task, it's represented) along with Cooking, Hobbies & Crafts, Needlework, and Biography along the east wall. Books in History, Military, and the various OLD categories abound! The remaining categories will be well represented; seek and you will find. We have not forgotten Media and Puzzles either.

The book sale begins Friday evening, June 6, from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. Friday evening is open to Friends only; you may purchase a membership at the door. On Saturday, Sunday, and Monday the sale is open to all patrons. Saturday the sale will run during library hours from 9:00 to 6:00. Sunday times will be 1:00 to 5:00, and books will be half off, or you may fill a bag for \$8. Please do not forget Bag Day! Monday, June 9, the sale will run from 9:00 to 3:00 and a bag of books will cost \$3. There are no limits to the number of bags you can purchase.
