All Grades

Kindergarten, 1st, and 2nd Grade Students

- Pencil box or pouch
- Glue sticks: Elmer's, Qty. 2*
- Scissors: Metal blade; pointed
- Watercolor set: 16 or 24; Crayola or Prang*
- Pencils: 10 sharpened (Ticonderoga suggested, no mechanical pencils)*
- Erasers: Qty. 2, pink or hi-polymer (Pentel)
- Colored pencils
- Ruler: wooden; 12"
- Mini dry eraser
- Dry erase markers: thin tip, preferably black; Qty. 4
- Small whiteboard for student use in class and home (9x12" is ideal)
- 1/2" ruled writing paper tablet to keep at home for homework
- 1 folder for sending homework to/from school
- 1 box of tissues (1 per family)*
- Hand sanitizer 12oz (1 per family)*
- Smock (for art and crafts)

3rd — 8th Grade Students

- Pencil box or pouch
- Pencils: 10 sharpened (Ticonderoga suggested, no mechanical pencils)*
- Highlighter (dry is ideal, or one that will not bleed through paper)
- Erasers: Qty. 2, pink or hi-polymer (Pentel)
- Dry erase markers: Qty. 4 (preferably black, thin tip)
- Mini dry eraser
- Scissors (label with name)
- Red pen or pencil*
- 1 binder / folder
- 1 pocket dictionary (for literature & composition)
- 1 box of tissues (one per family)*
- Notebook or loose-leaf paper (dividers recommended for multiple subjects)
- Hand sanitizer 12oz (1 per family)*
- Smock: optional (for art and crafts)

9th — 12th Grade Students

- Pencil box or pouch
- Pencils: 10 sharpened (Ticonderoga suggested, no mechanical pencils)*
- Highlighter (dry is ideal, or one that will not bleed through paper)
- Erasers: Qty. 2, pink or hi-polymer (Pentel)
- Dry erase markers: Qty. 4 (preferably black, thin tip)

- Red pen or pencil*
- 1 Qty. 2" binder / folder
- 1 pocket dictionary (for literature & composition)
