Constance Morris House is a Shelter for victims of Domestic Violence serving mainly the Western suburbs. Survivors are surrounded by a supportive and nurturing staff and environment to help them overcome the trauma of Domestic Violence.

Since 1979, this charity has worked to create a safe environment where domestic violence survivors are encouraged to learn about their options for change and empower themselves to make informed decisions about their future. Services are provided at NO COST.

- A domestic violence shelter, Constance Morris House, a place for survivors to find refuge as they flee abusive relationships
- Crisis intervention
- Case management
- Individual, family, and group therapy
- Legal and medical advocacy
- Onsite health care and referrals for shelter residents including wellness exams, triage and treatment for acute illness, and prenatal care
- Links to ongoing support services such as emergency financial assistance, substance abuse counseling, and housing programs
- **Community education and prevention**, to drive a unified response to domestic violence
