

Beds Plus Charity is a nonprofit organization that serves the needs of homeless individuals and families in our community. Their mission is to provide emergency overnight shelter, housing, and supportive services to help those in crisis regain stability and independence with the goal of breaking the cycle of homelessness.

PROGRAMS OFFERED

BEDS Plus offers a range of evidence-based programs to meet the varied and complex need of neighbors experiencing or facing homelessness.

Emergency Services connects complex need of neighbors experiencing or facing homelessness. Emergency Services connects people facing homelessness to immediate resources and services.

Interim Housing provides intensive short-term case management coupled with private, temporary housing at area motels and in scattered master leased apartments. Specialized case management is provided for families and persons with medical or mental disabilities.

Transitional Housing provides medium-term rental assistance until a client can become independent. A portion of the program is dedicated exclusively to transition aged youth, victims of violence and household involved in DCFS care.

Permanent Supportive Housing couples long-term, individualized support with rental assistance at agency-owned and master-leased, scattered community apartments.

APPROACH

Professional case managers facilitate client-directed plans to regaining and sustaining housing. Our wraparound services are trauma-informed, low-barrier and community integrated.
