The first actual Labor Day parade happened in NYC in 1882, where 10,000 workers from different union organizations took unpaid time to march from City Hall to Union Square. After the success of this march, members of the Central Labor Union had the idea to add a picnic following the annual parade and to sell tickets to fund raise. Prominent labor leaders were known to speak at these events. This yearly event was set forth as a "workingman's holiday" and it spread through industrial centers through out this country.
