



Jan 2018 to March 2019 (mb/d)




#### Production

- Iran's crude oil production dropped from 3.8 mb/d in January 2018 to 2.67 mb/d in March 2019.
- The crude oil production reduction was mostly from the Southern oil fields.
- Iran's condensate production did not drop, despite export cuts.


- Iran's oil sales dropped from 2.246 mb/d in January 2018 to 1.1 mb/d in March 2019
- In November, 8 countries (China, India, Japan, South Korea, Taiwan, Turkey, Greece and Italy) received waivers from the US for importing Iranian oil for the next 6 months.






