

One of our members, Kelly Liebe, participated in the 2022 Yukon River Quest at the end of June! Here's what she had to say about her experience:

"Step 1 - find a team - Paddlers Abreast check; find a coach -Zak. Prepare. Year 1 - Covid. Year 2 - High water. Year 3 - high water but we proceeded. We decided to do the 1/2 quest from Whitehorse

to Carmacks and on June 22 at 9 am our Voyageur canoe set out along with 105 other teams. We paddled non stop for 25 hours - through the twilight hours of the night and on into the morning; arriving in Carmacks at 11 am - 200 miles later. The River was high but so were our spirits. It was such an amazing journey and one that I could not have completed without the support of Zak and all the kids in the club who inspire me onward. I can't wait for my next adventure."



CanoeKids Workshop
