Entries must be received by June 26, 2024. Management may elect to accept entries day of but not guaranteed. prior to riding we must have paid and completed entry and releases.

Spectators welcome! Bring a chair.

Riders can choose to participate in arena practice and may participate in division classes offered for an additional fee.

Limited to one horse/rider combination per class, but can cross into Open class with same horse/rider if eligible. No sharing horses.

No dogs please.

Children under 18 must wear a helmet & be accompanied by an adult. stallions may not be ridden or handled by those under the age of 18, and not ALLOWED in youth class.

Not a sanctioned event. Using American Horsemen's Challenge regulations as guidelines.

All judges' decisions are final.

Bring water bucket for your horse.

Basic class descriptions and information: Youth and Legends classes: eligible riders in these classes are considered amateur riders. An amateur rider has not trained, assisted in training for remuneration, nor received compensation for instructing another person in riding for the previous 5 years. Youth is 18 and Under. Legends are 55 and over. Age as of January 1st of the current year. The course shall consist of 13 obstacles. YOUTH and LEGENDS riders may cross enter in OPEN class for additional fee. OPEN class is open to any level rider, regardless of experience, winnings or age. OPEN class will also have 13 obstacles but with more challenging elements. It should also be noted that classes will have three scoring elements (time, obstacle and horsemanship).

There are to be NO cash prizes awarded. Specific prizes will be awarded for 1st through 3rd. Additional prizes may be awarded if sponsored.
