

### **Between the Ears**

# Do you know how to take your horses vital signs?

Here in Mariposa we don't really have 4 distinct seasons, they all sorta run into each other. Summer is hot, Fall is warm for the most part, Winter is typically mild to start then comes on a bit stronger and then there's spring, my favorite time of year!

As we are coming off summer and headed into fall, slight weather changes can wreck havoc on your horse. Make sure your horse is drinking plenty of fresh water and always have a good quality hay/ forage source. If your horse seems off and you need to call the Vet, it's always best that you can do a vital signs check so you actually have some concrete info to share with your Vet other than: "Blossom seems off today..."

Invest in a stethoscope and a rectal thermometer, have electrolytes on hand

and get to know your horses baselines.

See ya in the arena or on the trail!

#### **Normal Adult Horse Vital Signs**

- Temperature 99-101°F
- Pulse 28-44 beats per minute
- Respiration 10-24 breaths per minute
- Mucous Membranes: Moist, healthy pink color
- Capillary Refill Time: Two seconds or less (time it takes for the gums to return to pink after being pressed with a finger)
- Gut Sounds: Gurgling, gaslike growls, "tinkling" "pinging" sounds, and occasionally "roars"
- Hydration: Pinch his neck/shoulder skin briefly, then release; generally, the skin should snap back to normal in 1 or 2 seconds. Any longer may indicate dehydration.




