Membership Eligibility

- The craft beverage maker must be located in Snohomish County and brew craft beer, wine, cider, mead, spirits, kombucha or be a coffee roaster for the Snohomish County market.
- New craft beverage makers (in business less than 1 year) must be brewing and selling their crafts under their own label to be eligible for membership.
- Dues for a craft beverage maker in its first year of operation are \$120.
- Dues for an existing brewery to join the Guild, or after its first year of operation, are \$240
