# 2023 CCHPC Summer Barrel Series Rules

#### **Entries and Fees**

- 1. Entries
  - a. Pre-entries will open one week before the event.
  - b. Exhibitions are limited and will be on the pre-entry form (if they do not fill, they will sell on-site)
  - c. Pre-entries will close at 6pm the evening before the race.
    - i. If participant does not receive a confirmation email, a chairperson must be notified. If you did not pay and the confirmation is not received, you are not registered!
  - d. Draw will be posted by 9pm evening before the race.
  - e. Any draw out requests must be received by a chairperson no later than midnight the evening prior to the race in order to receive a refund.
  - f. After midnight, NO REFUNDS
  - g. A horse may have a time once per race (one for each Open, Youth, and Poles). Different riders may use the same horse in different races.
- 2. Entry fees
  - a. Exhibitions: \$5 each (limit of 3 per horse, limit 60 seconds per horse)
  - b. Peewee (10 and under, CAN NOT RUN IN YOUTH): \$3
  - c. Youth (18 and under): \$20
  - d. Open: \$30
  - e. Open Poles: \$15
- 3. Office fees
  - a. On-site \$10 (this closes 30 minutes before open starts)
  - b. Nonmember online \$5
  - c. Member online \$FREE
- 4. Youth entries regarding carryover to Open.
  - a. If a rider pays for youth <u>and</u> open, they must choose <u>prior</u> to the race on the entry form, whether they will run twice or carry over their youth time to the open

### Year-end awards and points

- 1. Year-end awards
  - a. Rider/horse combination are used for year-end awards.
    - i. In the event the rider must use a horse other than the horse that is registered for the race, chairperson(s) must be notified before the office closes.
  - b. Rider/horse combination must compete in half or more of the events to be eligible for yearend awards, if half is an odd number, requirement will be rounded up (example 7 races, half is 3.5, required will be 4)
  - c. The goal is to award the best number of participants possible and will be as follows (number of places can be adjusted per chairperson(s) discretion if necessary):
    - i. 5D Open Barrels  $1^{st}$  thru  $6^{th}$
    - ii. 4D Youth Barrels  $1^{st}$  thru  $6^{th}$
    - iii. 3D Open Poles 1st thru 3rd
    - iv. Peewee Barrels  $-1^{st}$  and  $2^{nd}$  (must attend half of the races to be eligible)
  - d. Tie breaker rules
    - i. Number of races attended by horse/rider.
    - ii. Number of times placed in that division by horse/rider combination.
    - iii. Total amount of money won in the division by horse/rider combination.
    - iv. Fastest time for the division with horse/rider combination

## Order of events and expectations

- 1. Run order.
  - a. Exhibitions (limit of 50, typically takes about 1 hour)
  - b. Barrels Open/Youth followed by Peewees.
  - c. Exhibition Poles-limit to 10
  - d. Poles Poles Open
- 2. Exhibitions start Hour and a half before the open starts.
  - a. 60 seconds each, 45 second warning will be given by the announcer.
- 3. Runs start at posted times.
  - a. SATURDAY, Exhibitions start at 8:30am, Open starts at 10:00am.
  - b. SUNDAY, Exhibitions start at 11:00am, Open starts at 12:30pm.
  - c. Arena will **<u>not</u>** be open for riding after exhibitions.
- 4. Tractor drags.
  - a. Exhibition tractor after every 10.
  - b. Open and Youth Barrels drag after every 5.
    - i. In the event a runner has to draw out or is a no show, drag order will stay the same (example: runner 8 is a no-show, tractor will still run after #10 runner)
  - c. Drag after Open/Youth before Peewee

Drag After Exhibition Poles

- c. Open Poles drag after every 10.
- 5. Each rider is responsible for being ready at the gate.
  - a. Announcer will call 3 times for the rider, if the rider is not near the gate attempting to enter, announcer will move to the next rider after the 3<sup>rd</sup> call (Approximately 30 seconds to enter the arena)
  - b. If a rider misses their run, they will NOT be placed at the end and fees are not refunded.

## Payouts

- 1. Payouts
  - a. Payouts will be ready that day by check (<u>20 minutes after the last race</u>, or earlier if announced). Please do not run to the office while others are competing to ask if they are

ready. If a runner does not stay to obtain their check, it will be mailed out the following Monday.

- b. Checks will **<u>be combined onto 1 check</u>** if you earn money in more than 1 division.
- c. Payouts will not be held to pay for the next race.
- d. It is the participant's responsibility to provide CCHPC with accurate information.
