

2021 CCHPC Summer Barrel Series Rules

**In the event of a rain date held during the week, time changes will be announced *at least* 1 week before the event. Any announcements will be on Facebook and/or the website at capitalcityhorseandpony.org

**Changes made during the season per chair discretion, will be announced *at least* 1 week before an event.

Posted start time for each race is the start time of **EXHIBITIONS.

**Office opens at 10:00 am and closes 11:00 am. Pre-entries are much preferred.

Entries and fees

1. Entries
 - a. Pre-entries will open one week before the event
 - b. Exhibitions are limited and will be on the pre-entry form (if they do not fill, they will sell on-site)
 - c. Pre-entries will close at 5pm evening before the race
 - i. If participant does not receive a confirmation email, a chair person must be notified. If the confirmation is not received, you are not registered!
 - ii. Participant is not registered until paid
 - d. Draw will be posted by 10:00 pm evening before the race
 - e. Any draw out requests must be received by either chair-person no later than midnight the evening prior to the race in order to receive a refund
 - f. After midnight, no refunds
2. Entry fees
 - a. Exhibitions: \$3 each (limit of 5/person)
 - b. Peewee (10 and under): \$2
 - i. A 10 and under participant can run youth division, but cannot run peewee *and* youth division
 - c. Youth (18 and under): \$20
 - d. Open: \$30
 - e. Open Poles: \$15
3. Office fees
 - a. Pre-entry FREE!
 - b. On-site \$10 – office closes at 11: 00 am
4. Youth entries regarding carryover to Open
 - a. If a rider pays for youth and open, they must choose *prior* to the race on the entry form, whether they will run twice or carry over their youth time to the open.

Year-end awards and points

1. Prize Fees
 - a. \$20 for non-member
 - b. \$10 for CCHPC member
2. Year-end awards
 - a. Once the prize fee is paid, the rider is eligible to earn points for year-end awards. (example: rider does not pay year-end award fee until race 3, points will start accumulating as of race 3 even though rider participated in previous races)
 - b. Rider/horse combination are used for year-end awards
 - i. In the event the rider must use a horse other than the horse that is registered for the race, the chair person must be notified before the office closes.

- c. Rider/horse combination must compete in half or more of the events to be eligible for year-end awards, if half is an odd number, requirement will be rounded up (example 7 races, half is 3.5, required will be 4)
- d. The goal is to award the best number of participants possible and will be as follows (number of places can be adjusted per chair-person discretion if necessary):
 - i. 5D Open Barrels – 1st thru 6th
 - ii. 4D Youth Barrels – 1st thru 6th
 - iii. 3D Open Poles – 1st thru 3rd
 - iv. Peewee Barrels – 1st and 2nd (must attend half of the races to be eligible)

3. Point calculations

Order of events and expectations

1. Run order
 - a. Exhibition Barrels - limit of 40, typically takes about 1 hour
 - b. Barrels – peewee, youth, followed by open
 - c. Exhibition Poles - limit of 10
 - d. Poles – Open only
2. Exhibitions start at 10:30 am sharp
 - a. Limit to 40 exhibitions, no more than 5 per rider
 - b. 60 seconds each, 45 second warning will be given by the announcer
 - c. Please be respectful of the time limit in order to keep the show moving efficiently
3. Runs start *approximately* 11:30 am – office closes 11:00 am
 - a. Arena will not be open for riding after exhibitions
 - b. Once exhibitions are done, tractor will drag and peewee will start *immediately* once able
4. Tractor drags
 - a. Exhibition – tractor after every 10 and once complete to start peewee
 - b. Drag after peewee regardless of number of entries

- c. Youth and Open Barrels – drag after every 5
 - i. In the event a runner has to draw out or is a no show, drag order will stay the same (example: runner 8 is a no-show, tractor will still run after #10 runner)
- d. Open Poles – drag after every 10
5. Each rider is responsible for being ready at the gate
 - a. Announcer will call 3 times for the rider, if the rider is not near the gate attempting to enter, announcer will move to the next rider after the 3rd call
 - b. If a rider misses their run, they will NOT be placed at the end and fees are not refunded

Payouts

1. Payouts
 - a. Payouts will be sent within 1 week of race day. No payouts night of the race.
 - b. Money will be paid via PayPal (or possible other electronic means) or mail. Electronic means will be done first.
 - i. If participant PayPal address differs from the email registered with, it is participants responsibility to have it correct on the pre-entry form
 - c. Payouts will not be held to pay for the next race
 - d. If rider does not provide PayPal or mailing address within 1 week of race day, winnings will be forfeited
 - e. It is participants responsibility to provide CCHPC with accurate information
