CRITERIA

1. This scholarship is for family members of Fred Douglass Alumni.
2. Applicant **must** be a student enrolled for Fall 2021. **Proof of enrollment is required.**
3. Applicant must submit a 2 page, APA style 12pt font, double-spaced essay entitled “Continuing the Legacy of Service.” Applicant should suggest and expound on a plan for the organization to continue its legacy of service. (Research Fred Douglass High School). **(Maximum points 40)**
4. Applicant should have a minimum GPA of 2.7. **(MUST submit an official school transcript). (Maximum points 20)**
5. Two letters of recommendation: **(Maximum points 20)**
 - A person who has known you for at least two years (non-family member).
 - A second letter from a business owner, school official, an educator, a community leader, clergyman, organization official, etc.
 - Letters of recommendation must be dated and signed. Also, they must be specific and not “generic”. Letters will not be accepted separately. It is your responsibility to obtain and include letters with your application.
6. Include all honors, awards, activities, work experience and/or community involvement. **(Maximum points 20).**
7. The complete application packet must be postmarked and submitted on or before April 19, 2021.
