

West Masonic Lodge #475 2024 Scholarship Application

Deadline for Entry April 26th, 2024

In the Spring of 2024, the West Masonic Lodge #475 will award (3) scholarships to graduating high school seniors. Two students from **West High School** and one student from **Gholson High School**. All applicants must be graduating seniors planning to attend college or vocational-trade school for the **upcoming Fall Semester**. Applicants must be either U.S. citizens or be verified legal immigrants. The awarded funds will be submitted directly to the students' school of choice and payable for the benefit of the winning student. If **for any reason the student fails to enroll in school, we will ask that the institution return the scholarship funds to West Lodge**. Final selection is by a panel of (3) judges from West Lodge's Scholarship Committee. Awarded applicants will be notified approximately 10 days after the official deadline.

Eligibility – To be eligible, applicants must meet the following criteria:

• Applicant must be a student of (select one)

Gholson ISD High School

- Attendance requirements followed.
- Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 75% both Junior and Senior years.
- Applicant must be a graduating senior, who plans to attend either a four-year institution, community college, or vocational training institution upon graduation, and must enroll for the upcoming Fall semester to receive the scholarship funds.
- Applicant must not have any discipline referrals, no failing grades Junior and Senior year, no disruptive behavior, suspension, or demerits.


