The Lodge that has the most candidates from the Spring and Fall of 2020 will get \$250.00 from the Valley of Danville to do with as they please!




Building Upgrades

B. Stephen Daugherty, 33°

Ill. Brother B. Stephen Daugherty, 33° began his Masonic journey in Hutton Lodge #698, located at Diona, Illinois by receiving all three degrees in September of 1978. He served his lodge as Worshipful Master in 1982 and 1993. After becoming a plural member of Charleston Lodge #35 in 1984, he served as Master of this lodge in 1986 and 1987. He is also a member of Belleville Lodge #65 in Cartersburg, Indiana.

After joining The Valley of Danville, ASSR, in the George E. Burow class in the fall of 1978, Ill. Brother Daugherty immediately became active in the PI Nucleus group of degree extras. He was asked to join the Council Princes of Jerusalem officer line in 1986, serving as Sovereign Prince in 1990-1991. Election as 1st Lt. Commander of Danville Consistory followed in 1994. He served the valley as Commander in Chief in 1996-1998. Working with two talented groups of presiding officers, notable accomplishments of the valley during his tenure included 2 Family Life Week awards, 2 Franklin awards, and at a time when typical class sizes were 50-60, a class of over 150. The passport program was introduced during this period and was then copied by the Supreme Council and adopted for the entire Northern Masonic Jurisdiction. He then served the valley as an at-large director during the years 2000-2006. He was coroneted a 33rd degree Mason in 1993.

Ill. Brother Daugherty and his wife Wanda relocated to Plainfield, Indiana in 1996. He is retired from a career in management.

Caring for your Masonic Treasures by Jeffrey Croteau

The Scottish Rite Masonic Museum & Library often receives calls from Masonic lodges and Valleys asking how to preserve their historic documents—charters, minute books, and certificates—as well as photographs and books. We have updated and revised one of our most popular resources, *Caring for Your Masonic Treasures*. This 21-page booklet is now available at https://www.srmml.org/caring-for-your-masonic-treasures. Feel free to consult the PDF online, download it to your device, or print it out.

We hope this booklet will help you get started with preserving your lodge's or Valley's historic material. The booklet outlines various preservation techniques and explains:

- The kinds of materials you might encounter in your collection
- The ideal conditions in which to store your collections
- The types of storage enclosures (boxes, folders, etc.) to use when storing your collections

How to contact and hire a professional conservator to repair damaged documents and books.

We hope that the guidelines in *Caring for Your Masonic Treasures* will help you feel confident that you are doing what you can to help insure the long-term preservation of your lodge's or Valley's documents, photographs, and books.
