Links members contribute more than 500,000 documented hours of community service annually – strengthening our communities and enhancing the nation.

The Piedmont Chapter of The Links, Incorporated is committed to contributing to the growth and development of area students by awarding scholarships to students residing in Gaston, Catawba and Cleveland Counties. The National Center for Education Statistics reports a continued pronounced racial gap in college and university enrollment between African American students and their Caucasian counterparts. In an effort to encourage and to assist in the continuing education of young African American men and women, this year the chapter will award **three (3) scholarships in the amount of \$750.00 each**. The scholarship may be used to assist with tuition, purchase of books, food, lodging and/or transportation.

Application Instructions:

The application should be completed and submitted on or before March 31, 2024, at 11:59pm. The completed application, transcripts and letters of recommendation must be received by March 31, 2024, in order to be reviewed by the scholarship committee. Late applications and information received after the deadline will not be accepted for scholarship review.

Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible for a 2024 Piedmont Chapter Scholarship, a student must:

- 1. Be a resident of Gaston, Catawba or Cleveland Counties; and
- 2. Be a graduating African American high school senior that has been accepted to a college or university for the coming fall semester; or
- 3. Be a current African American college student in good academic standing with the college or university, and
- 4. Submit a completed 2024 Piedmont Chapter Scholarship application, including a copy of transcript, a recent headshot photograph, and two letters of recommendation by the established deadline (March 31, 2024)

The Application:

- 1. The application packet is available directly from a member of the Piedmont Chapter of The Links, Incorporated or from a member of one of our local civic organizations or churches.
- 2. Applications should be either typed (electronic application is a fillable document) or neatly printed using black or blue ink.
- 3. All applications are to be signed and dated by applicant. Parent or legal guardian's signature is required for applicants under 18 years of age.
- Letters of recommendation should include statements relative to the applicant's qualities, accomplishments, contributions and/or personal characteristics. Letters must include signature and position of person writing the letter. An electronic signature is acceptable.
- 5. Transcript(s), letters of recommendation, and letter of acceptance or verification of current/continued enrollment in college or university, must be included in the application packet. An application checklist is included to assist with organizing your application.
- 6. A recent photo (school picture type) should be submitted with the application to be used for publicity purposes only. Photo specifications are outlined on the *Application Checklist.*
