A life-long student of the American Civil War, Michael Block moved to southern Fauquier County in 2004 where he developed a deep appreciation and love of Culpeper County and what happened on that historic ground during the Civil War. He has been giving battlefield tours and lectures for a number of years, focusing on the counties of Culpeper and Fauquier. He has also been collecting photographs, drawings, and first-person accounts of events, both significant and mundane, that occurred in the region during the war and believes that Culpeper was the war's most photographed county. Block has been on the Board of Directors of the Friends of Cedar Mountain

Battlefield since 2012 and is currently serving as its vice-president. He has also served on the Board of the Brandy Station Foundation and on both the Culpeper and Fauquier Sesquicentennial Committees.
