George L. Fickett Jr., a lifelong resident of Prince George County, Virginia, worked for Chesterfield County for forty-five years in Environmental Engineering and Geographic Information Services. His interest in the Civil War began at age nine after watching an episode of Playhouse 90 about the Battle of the Crater. In 1972, he became particularly interested in the Bermuda Hundred Campaign and started efforts to preserve Civil War sites in Chesterfield County in 1985.

Over the years, he successfully preserved 11 sites, developed a self-guided driving tour, and contributed to the Civil War Trail network. George has received numerous awards for his preservation efforts, including the President's Award from the Civil War Trust in 2012. He has been featured in several publications and recognized by renowned historian Ed Bearss in 2015. Currently, George serves as a Board Member of the Petersburg Battlefields Foundation and is involved with various historical organizations, continuing his work as a historian and preservationist.
