"Nathan Hall is an interpretive ranger at Richmond National Battlefield and Maggie L. Walker National Historic Site. He received his undergraduate degree in history from VCU and worked locally at the Valentine Museum. Nathan received his master's degree from Louisiana State University writing a thesis examining the identity of Chief Justice John Marshall as a Federalist in the South and in Thomas Jefferson's Virginia. He worked for the National Park Service at Jean Lafitte National Historical Park and Preserve, site of the Battle of New Orleans in the War of 1812. Nathan has returned to his hometown and continues to research the history of Richmond in the times of secession, Civil War, and Reconstruction."
