Give your students the opportunity to discuss the following:

<u>RACE STRATEGY..</u>

An assortment of related activities that can be incorporated into the overall lesson plan as needed

ACTIVITIES:

- Draw two comic strips: one about a selfish person, the other about a person that shares freely with others.
- Pair and Share: Discuss how you feel when a friend won't share with you. How do you think others feel when you don't share with them?
- Discuss as a class whether a person has to share even if they don't want to and whether there are times when it's okay not to share.

REVVED UP & READY TO GO

Here is a Physical Fitness activity or game that is related to the word which can be used in Gym Time, Recess or after school programs

//PASS IT ON

Object: Students work together to successfully relay a message to the person at the front of the line.

How To Play:

Divide the students into groups of 4-6 people. Have them line up single-file facing the same direction. For the first round have the person at the back of the line secretly choose a single digit number. They will then draw it with their finger on the back of the person in front of them, who in turn does the same to the person in front of them. The number continues to be passed without saying anything up to the person at the front of the line, who attempts to guess what number was chosen at the start. If they are correct, the team gets a point. The person at the front moves to the back and starts the next round by choosing a letter between A-Z. The third round is emoji faces. The fourth round is animals and so on for each successive round. The team with the most points wins. In the event of a tie, the tie breaker is drawing a funny face and the person at the front must attempt to imitate the face drawn on their back.
