# **Colonial Beach's Greatest Asset -- Volunteers**

During 2019, volunteers with Colonial Beach's various nongovernmental organizations (NGOs) -- not including first responders -- contributed 42,000 volunteer hours. Colonial Beach Community Foundation (CBCF) President, Eric Nelson, calculated the monetary value of those hours to be \$1.1 million. Of that total number, CBCF volunteers contributed 6,900 hours (a \$200,000 value); and Chamber of Commerce volunteers, 28,000 hours (\$800,000).
