Hollis Milton is the Superintendent of the highly rated West Feliciana Parish School District. He began as Superintendent in June 2010. The district letter grade improved from a “B” to an “A” that year, and has continued at the top level for four consecutive years. Superintendent Milton is the current President of the Louisiana Association of School Superintendents, having previously held the offices of Secretary, Treasurer, and Vice President. Superintendent Milton is the current Chair of the influential Parish Superintendent’s Advisory Council.

Hollis is a graduate of Southeastern Louisiana University and holds a Master of Educational Leadership from LSU. Previously, he has been recognized as a two-time Teacher of the Year in East Baton Rouge Parish and a Principal of the Year in East Baton Rouge Parish.
