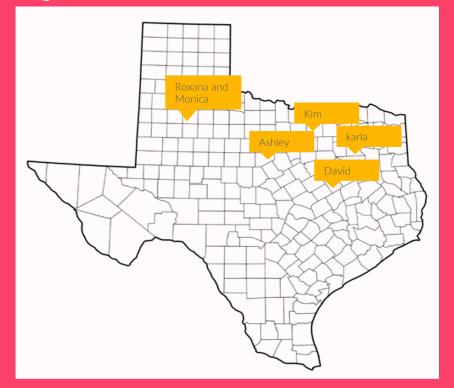

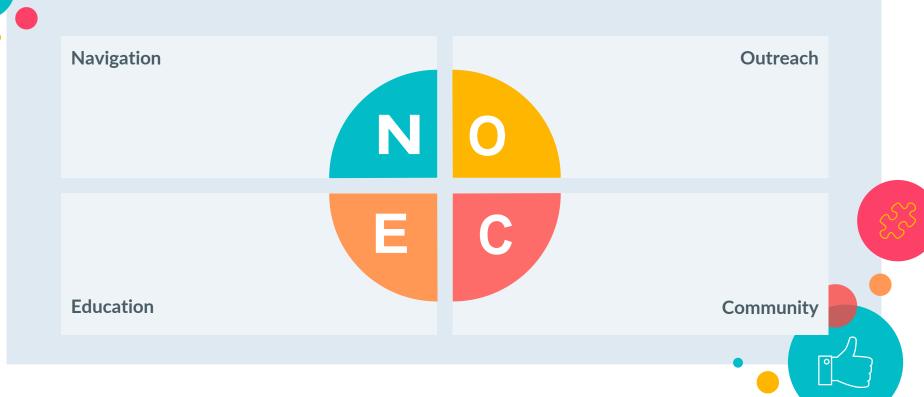

- Translation
- Patient follow ups
- Resource management
- Informal medication reconciliation / education
- Navigation of health care system / Resources
- Scheduling administration
- Participate in a multidisciplinary team / interprofessional collaborative practice team
