PROFILE

The Spring Grove Area Historical Preservation Society serves the townships of Heidelberg, Jackson, North Codorus, and Paradise; also, the boroughs of Jefferson, New Salem, Seven Valleys, and Spring Grove; located in south-central Pennsylvania in York County. The area encompasses approximately 92 square miles. This is primarily residential/rural. In 2020 the population was 27,998 with total households of 10,473. Ethnicity (%) breakdown is White – 95.2; Black – 2.1; Hispanic – 2.2; Asia - .5. Our mission is to provide a historical legacy for this and future generations of Spring Grove area residents.

Spring Grove Area Historical Preservation Society maintains over 10,000 artifacts. The extensive collection of objects includes furniture (including 2 player pianos), textiles (1890-present), household objects, business accoutrements, militaria, school items, band items, and architectural pieces. Our Archives and Library consists of land instruments (patents, surveys, indentures, etc.) dating from 1750 to the 1950's; the Glatfelter Paper Company's full set of monthly newsletters including the photo archives from 1940-1960; personal and professional letters, postcards, and photos; and books on local and Pennsylvania history. Also included in our archives is an extensive genealogy section.

SGAHPS offers use of our Archives to the Spring Grove Area School District, including History Clubs, to aid teachers in preparing primary/secondary source lesson plans for their students. Members access our collection of genealogy. The Museum is open 216 days a year to the public. We offer tours. Our future plans include acquiring a permanent home for our collections. Archival storage is used for the items not on display and care is always given to mediate environmental factors.




