# GUIDELINES

**APPLICATION DEADLINE: APPLICATIONS ARE ACCEPTED ON A ROLLING BASIS UNTIL NOVEMBER 1, 2022, OR UNTIL FUNDS ARE DEPLETED.**

Funding will be made available to survivors impacted by the 2020 Creek Fire to assist with their unmet needs relating to the survivor's recovery and rebuilding plan. Funding is available for: debris removal, soil testing, hazard tree removal, water storage containers, tools, equipment, construction materials, labor, permit fees, furniture, appliances, and more. Funds will be paid directly to vendors for goods and services if awarded. No reimbursements will be permitted and no survivors will be given cash directly.



## MAXIMUM INCOME CRITERIA

Number of Persons in household:

1-4 people: \$104,650

5-8 people: \$138,150

9+ people: add 8% for every additional member

## QUALIFYING CRITERIA

- One grant application per household
- Households/couples not filing jointly may not apply for separate grants.
- Be enrolled in the Disaster Case Management Program.
- Must have been impacted by the 2020 Creek Fire.
- Income must not exceed the income criteria below. Qualifying income is Adjusted Gross Annual Income.

## REQUIRED ATTACHMENTS

1. Copy of State issued ID for the applicant
2. Proof of income (W2, 1099, Tax Returns)
3. Proof of ownership or rental
4. If, Creek Fire affected, proof of residence in 2020
5. Contracts from Licensed and Insured Contractors or estimates for requests.
