# GUIDELINES

APPLICATION DEADLINE: JUNE 16, 2023

GRANT PERIOD:  
JULY 1 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2023

Funding from this program is available to assist uninsured or underinsured survivors that had a loss of a primary residence due to the 2020 Creek Fire. Funding is available for uninsured expenses such as debris removal, soil testing, hazard tree removal, water storage containers, tools, equipment, construction materials, labor, permit fees, furniture, appliances, and more. Funds will be paid directly to vendors for goods and services if awarded. No reimbursements will be permitted and no survivors will be given cash directly. Funding for construction projects is conditional upon following California Building Code and proposed projects are required to pull permits as necessary.



## QUALIFYING CRITERIA

- One grant application per household
- Households/couples not filing jointly may not apply for separate grants.
- Grants cannot be retroactive.
- Be enrolled in the Disaster Case Management Program.
- Must have been impacted by the 2020 Creek Fire.
- Income must not exceed the income criteria below. Qualifying income is Adjusted Gross Annual Income.

## MAXIMUM INCOME CRITERIA

Number of Persons in household:

1-4 people: \$104,650

5-8 people: \$138,150

9+ people: add 8% for every additional member

## REQUIRED ATTACHMENTS

1. Copy of State issued ID for the applicant
2. Proof of income (W2, 1099, Tax Returns)
3. Proof of ownership or rental
4. If, Creek Fire affected, proof of residence in 2020
5. Contracts from Licensed and Insured Contractors or estimates for requests.
6. Permits must be pulled if required by the Fresno County Department of Public Works and Planning.

**Please note if you are a previous awardee, you do not need to resubmit items 1-4. Please only submit items 5 & 6.**
